- I will require my team to uphold Lou Gehrig's zero tolerance policy or treating other players, managers, coached, Board Members, parents and spectators with respect; regardless of race, sex, sexual orientation, religion, creed or ability.
- I will refrain from any and all vulgar, lewd or obscene language or gestures while participating in or watching any league sponsored event whether home or away.
- I will direct all my comments and criticisms to parents, participants, umpires and Board Members away from children participating in the league, and conduct myself in a calm, civilized manner when doing so.
- I will read the Lou Gehrig Youth Baseball/Softball Managers Manual and agree to abide by those rules, responsibilities and Code of Conduct.

Violation of these rules could result in disciplinary action up to and including permanent dismissal from the Lou Gehrig youth Baseball/Softball league.
